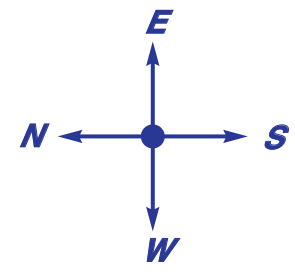

- Oaks Park provides a beautiful setting for both indoor and outdoor weddings and receptions.
- Talk about excitement, Oaks boasts one of the largest roller skating rinks on the West Coast, which includes a hardwood floor and a beautiful Wurlitzer Theatre Pipe Organ!
- Roller skating is available year round.
- The rides open mid-March and continue through September.
