

ATMOSFEAR

RIDE DESCRIPTION

An exciting ride with circulating and oscillating up and down motion. AtmosFEAR 180° swings riders approximately 50 feet into the air. AtmosFEAR 360° swings riders approximately 99 feet into the air and includes full inversions.

HEIGHT • WEIGHT • AGE REQUIREMENTS

Riders must be at least 48 inches tall to ride AtmosFEAR 180°.

Riders must be at least 52 inches tall to ride AtmosFEAR 360°.

Riders with recent surgeries or illnesses; pre-existing heart trouble; high blood pressure or aneurysms; neck, back, or bone problems; pregnancy; under the influence of drugs or alcohol; or any other physical condition that may be aggravated by this ride should not participate. Guests with pacemakers should not ride.

RIDE RULES

- 1 No loose articles are permitted on the ride. Riders must stow all loose articles in a locker/cubby or leave them with a non-rider. Oaks Park is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. Loose articles include: Hats, sunglasses, cameras, cell phones, backpacks, wallets, scarves, GoPros, etc.
- 2 All riders must be able to maintain a seated upright position in the ride at all times.
- 3 All restraints must be positioned and fastened properly in order for guests to ride. Due to the nature of the restraints, some larger guests may not be able to ride.
- 4 It is imperative that all riders comply with all safety speeches or signaled instructions given/posted by the operators.
- 5 No smoking is permitted on the midway or in the ride areas.
- 6 Food, beverages, and gum are permitted in the queue line but are not permitted on the ride.
- 7 Shirt and shoes must be worn at all times (unless shoes will be lost during the ride).
- 8 Riders with prosthesis must consult with guest services prior to waiting in line or riding.
- 9 No lap children or handheld infants are permitted.

ADA INFORMATION



MUST TRANSFER FROM WHEELCHAIR. Riders should proceed to the exit gate and wait for the ride operator to open the gate prior to entering the attraction. Riders must step up and down into the vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair/scooter to the ride vehicle.

RIDER RESPONSIBILITY STATEMENT

There are inherent risks in the participation in or on any amusement ride, device, or attraction. Riders have a duty to properly use all ride or device safety equipment provided.
